

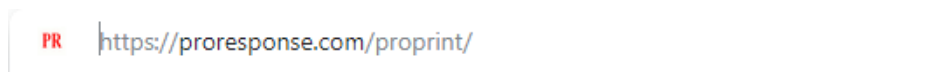
# ProPrint 4.72 Setup Instructions

(Compatible with both 32 and 64 bit Windows 7, 8, 8.1 and 10)

Open your Internet Browser (Chrome, Firefox, Edge, IE, Safari, etc.)



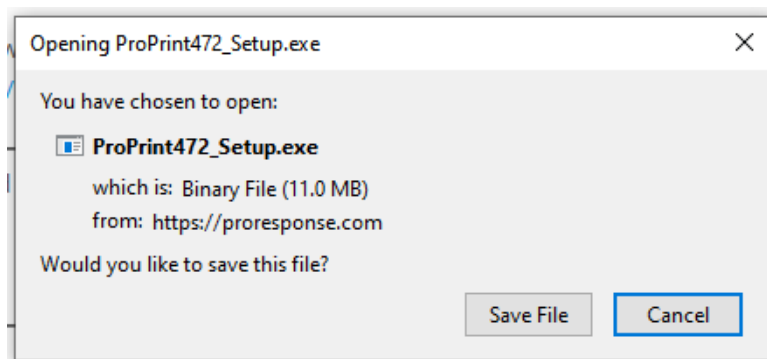
Next, type the following address into the address bar: <https://proresponse.com/proprint/>



This will open the ProPrint Download Page. Click on “ProPrint v4.72 (Beta)”

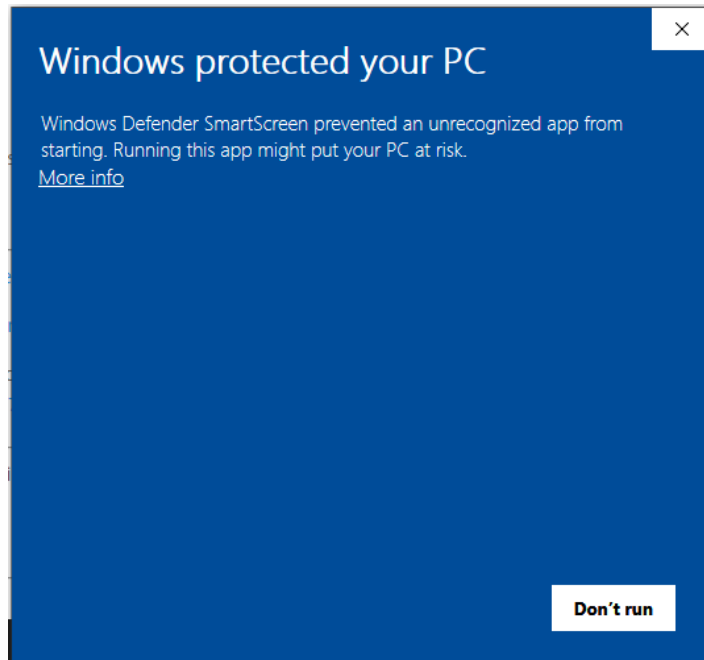

Depending upon your browser, the file will start to download or prompt you to run the program.

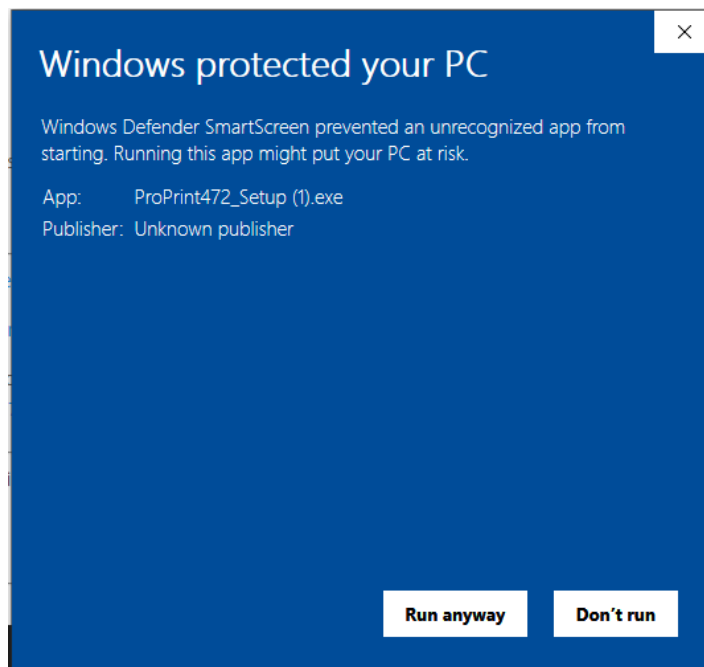


(Firefox prompt shown.)

After download is complete, depending upon your version of Windows, you may be alerted to a security risk.

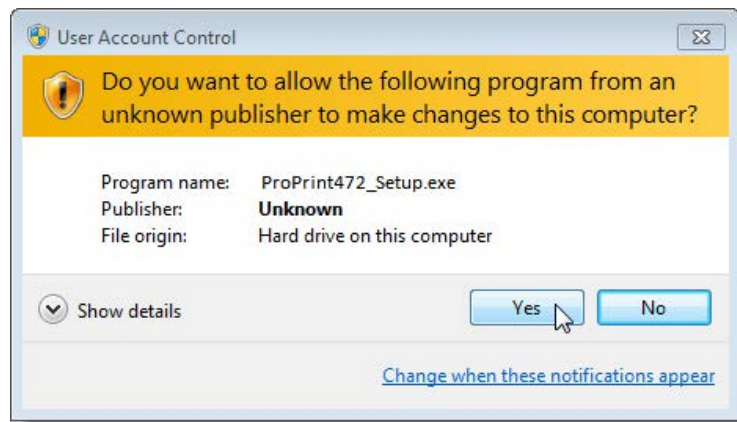


If you see this screen, click on More info and you will see the following screen:

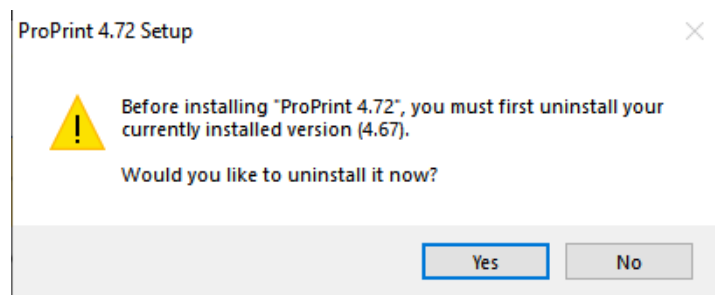


Click "Run anyway" and the installation will proceed.

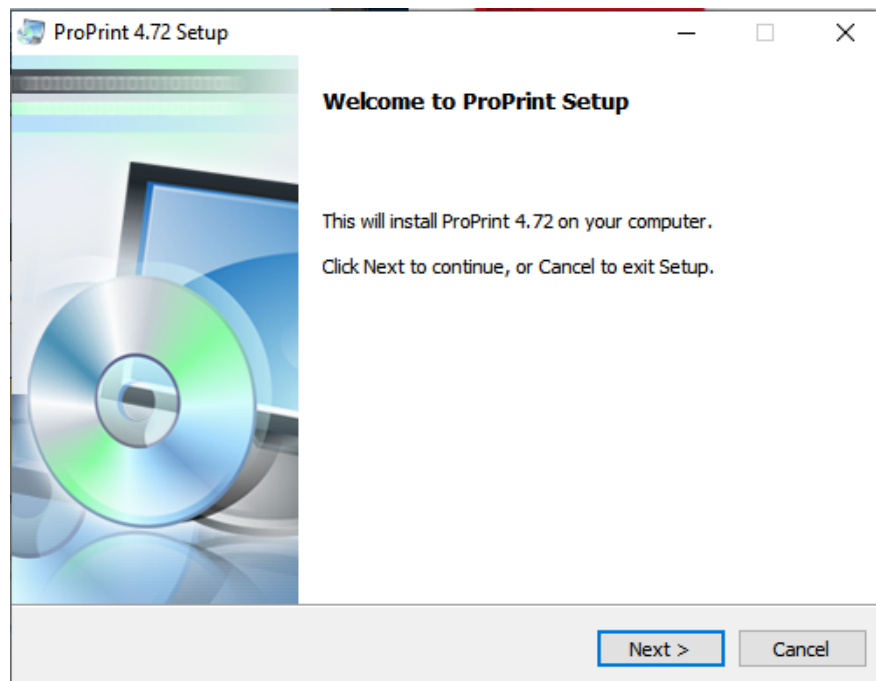
You may see another warning from Windows' User Account Control. If you see this warning, just click Yes.



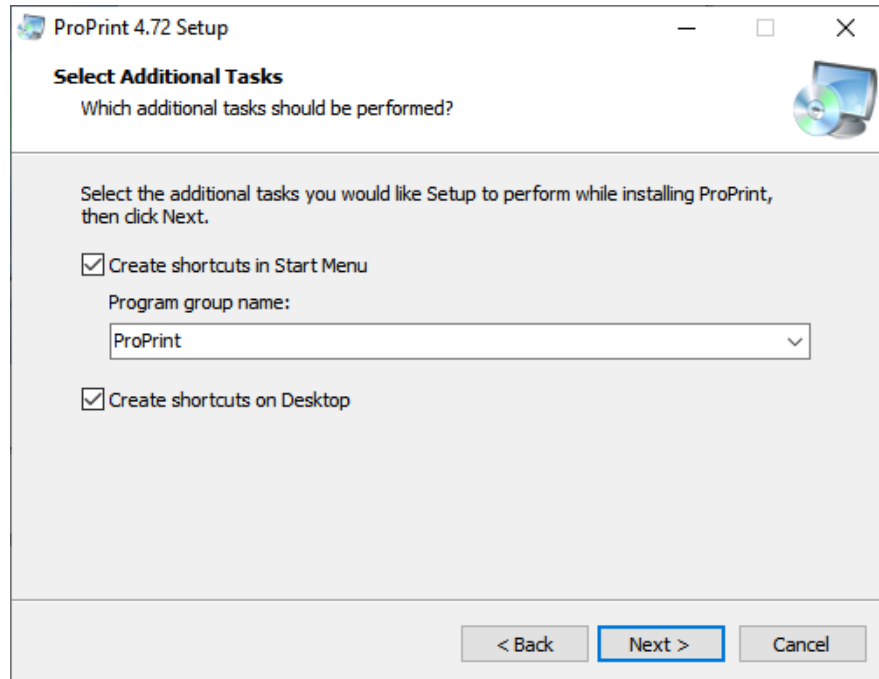
The following dialog box may appear if you have ProPrint already installed. You can click yes to uninstall the old version (make sure you have exited it before doing so.)



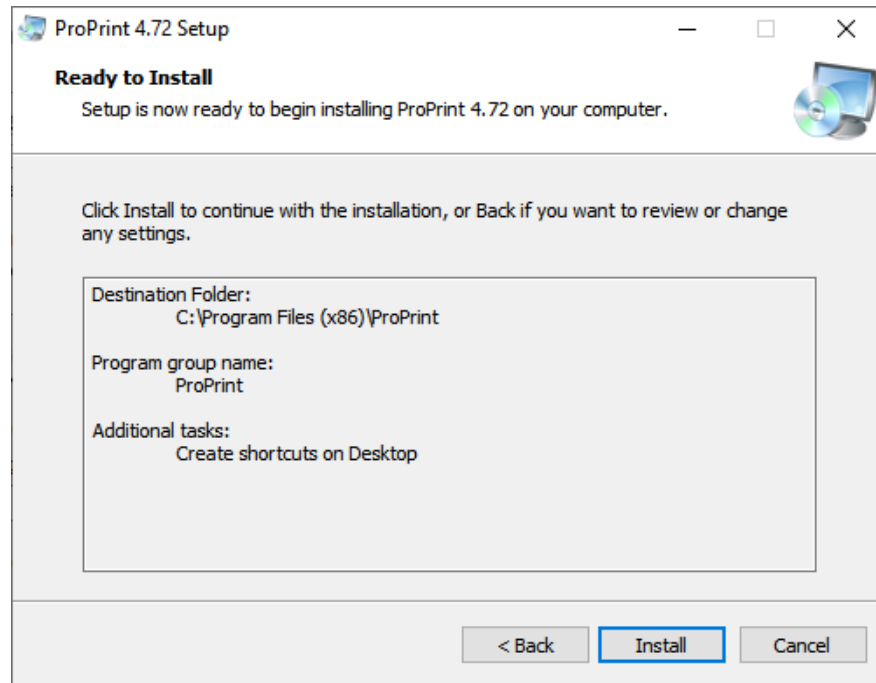
Now the Setup program will open. Click "Next" to begin the setup



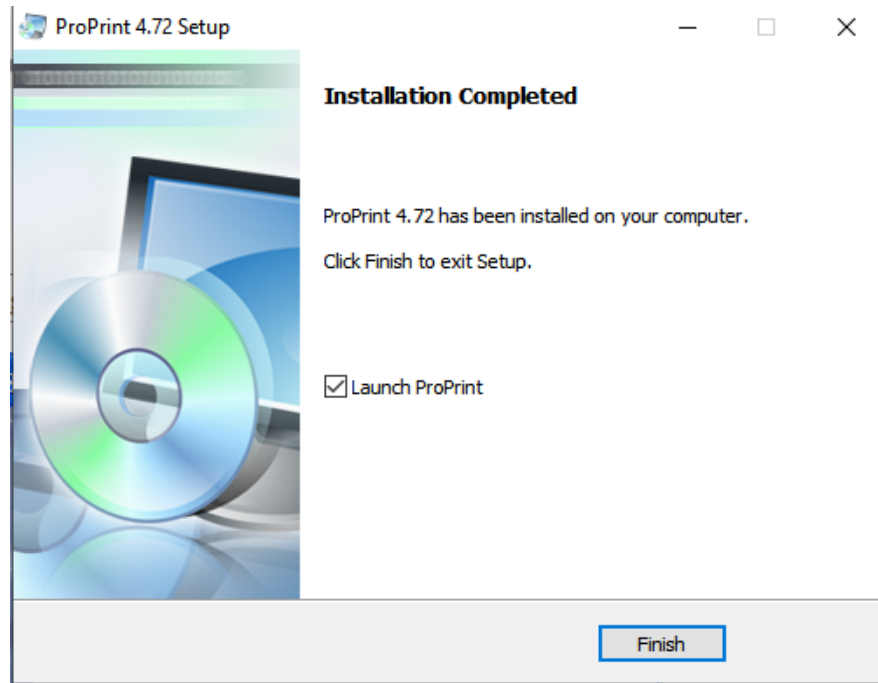
Setup will prompt you to create the program group name and whether or not to create shortcuts. Click Next to proceed.



Click Install to proceed.

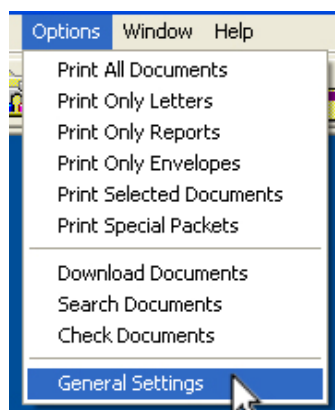


It will now run through and install the program. Once it has completed, click “Finish”.

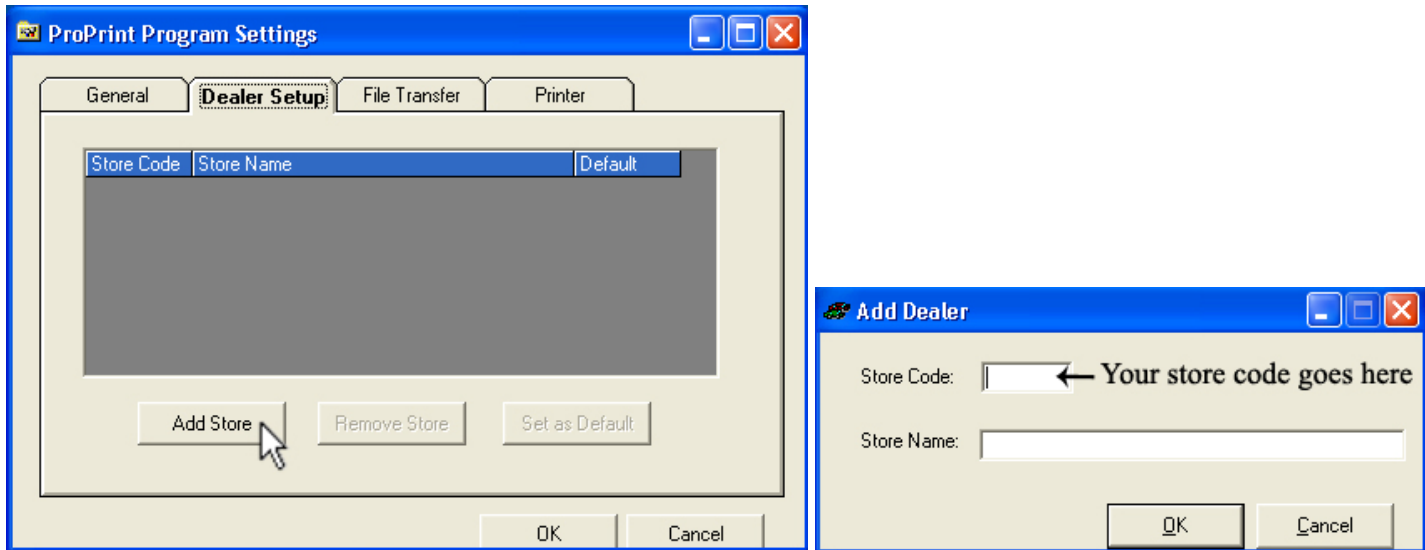


\*Note\* If this is a new install, you will receive an error message when ProPrint first opens. *THIS IS NORMAL.* Simply close out of the error message and the other open window and continue to follow the below steps.

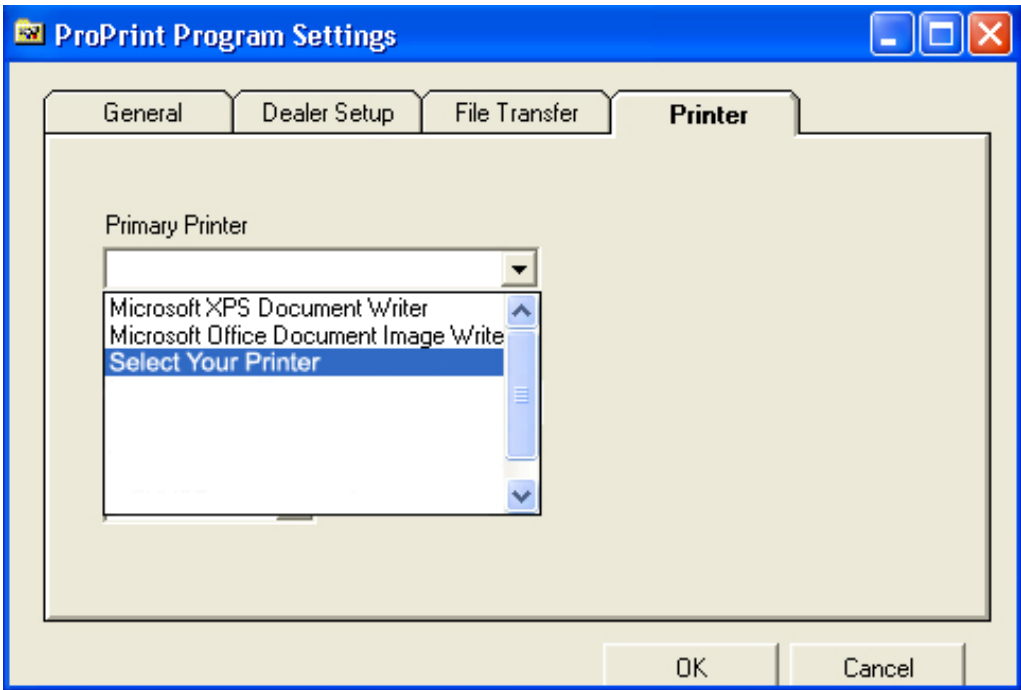
Click on “Options” then select “General Settings”



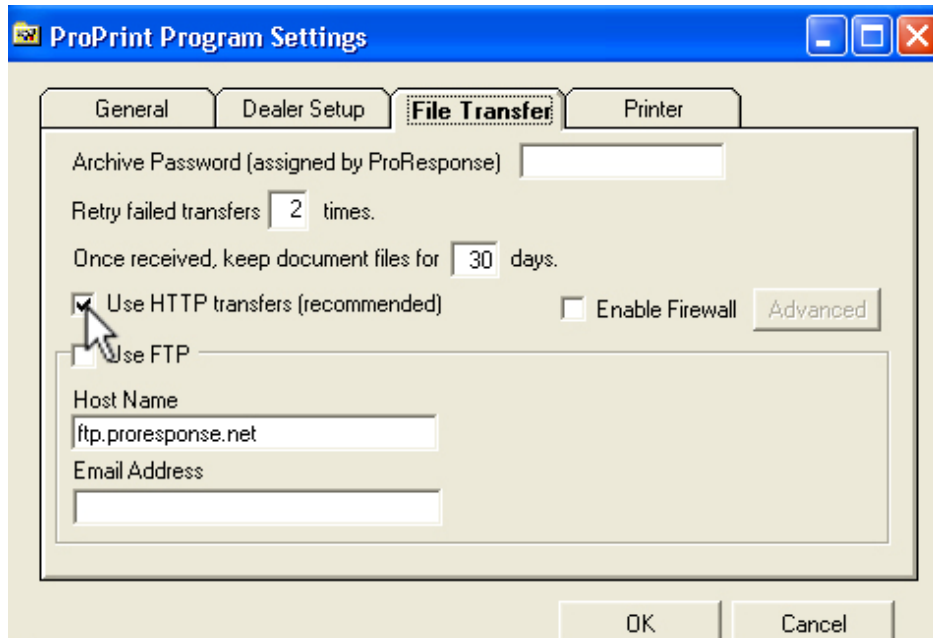
Go to the “Dealer Setup” tab and select to “Add Store”. Here you will add your dealer code. Once finished, click “Ok” to the “Add Dealer” window.



Next, go to the “Printer” tab up top. Select the printer used from the drop down list. If the printer is not listed, it may need to be installed.



Finally, go to the “File Transfer” tab. Make sure that the “Use HTTP transfers (recommended)” is checked.



Click “Ok” to the leave the settings window.

Congratulations! ProPrint is set up and ready to use. You can now download and print your files as normal.
